Communication and Language


Children will be exposed to a wide range of new vocabulary linked to our topic. They will use this to present and describe their boats to the class and also to share their experiences of being on a boat.


Physical Development

- Refining their fine motor skills using a variety of tools such a scissors and paintbrushes in order to build model boats.


Literacy
