Computing

In computing this term we are learning about programming using Scratch. We will explore how to:

- Create backdrops and sprites in a Scratch project
- Use motion blocks to move sprites
- Join blocks of code together to create a sequence of commands
- Design and create a project using multiple sprites and backdrops
- Create a musical instrument in Scratch using programming tools learnt this half term

Music

- Singing songs with a wider pitch range, breath control and thinking about emphasis and dynamics to make our singing more expressive.
- Using known pitches and rhythms to create a jungle composition in small groups.

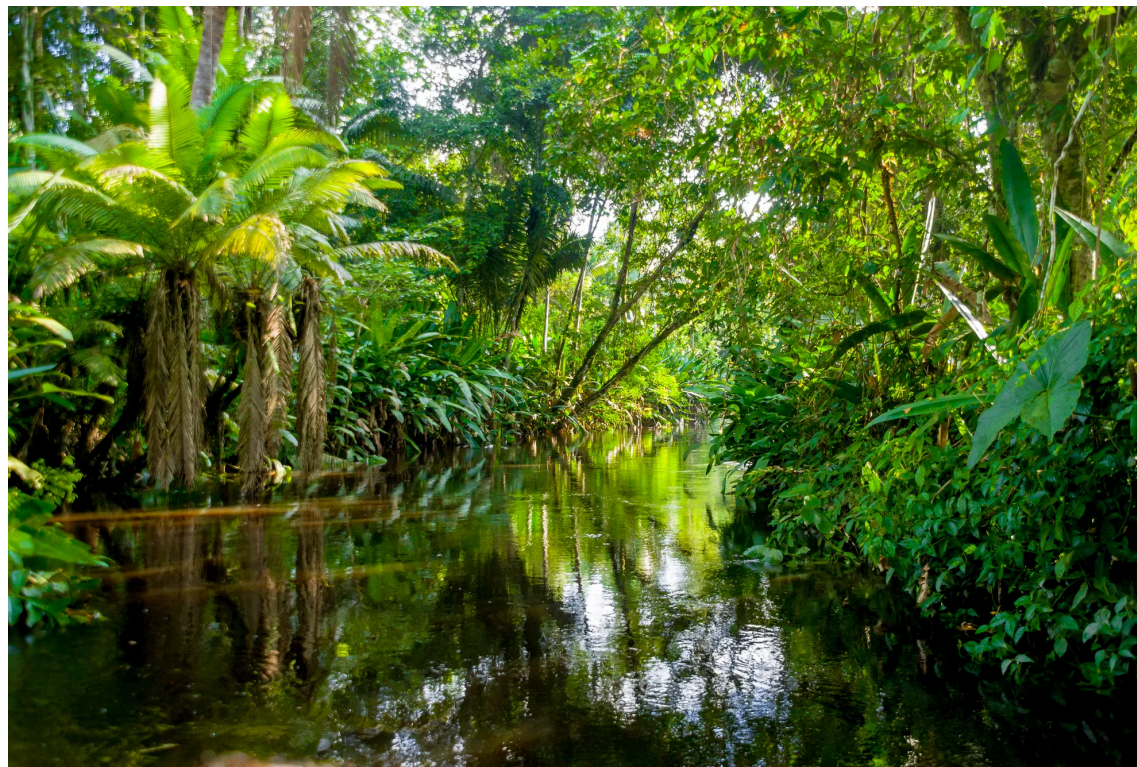
Maths

- Fractions on a number line
- Equivalent fractions
- Adding and subtracting fractions
- Finding unit and non-unit fractions of an amount
- Measuring mass using grams and kilograms
- Measuring volume and capacity using litres and millilitres

Our topic is 'Healthy Me' and our learning intentions are:

- Understanding how exercise affects our bodies.
- Understanding how the amount of calories, fat and sugar I put in to my body will affect my health.
- Learning strategies for keeping myself safe and knowing who to go to for help.
- Identifying when something feels safe or unsafe.
- Understanding how complex our bodies are and how important it is to take care of them.

History
